A Bad Prognosis with a Happy Ending

I saw the signs. I was in the wilderness in a cabin. Opening the door to enjoy the fresh mountain air, I noticed dark movement in the woods. Was it a bear? "Close the door," my brain warned. Before I could, the bear raced toward me. Instinctively, I turned and covered my face with my hands. Trying to slow my racing heart, I irrationally attempted to stop quivering, hoping the bear would sniff my hair, decide I was harmless as a rock, and move on. It was a futile attempt. Huge furry arms enveloped me.

Many of us consider the Bible's warning of end times as I did the bear. We see the movement. The darkening of our nation and world is upon us. Yet we hope that if we turn off the news the darkness will go away and everything will be okay. That is not the case. The Bible speaks clearly about the days ahead. This session will answer the question, "Why study Bible prophecy?"

End Times: What You Should Know

To dismiss prophecy is to dismiss one-third of the Bible.¹
