- ____ This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come.
- 4. Picture the disciples holding on to each word as the eternal Christ tells them what only He could know would happen in the end times. Matthew 24:15-28.
 - Therefore, when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place,
 - then there will be a great tribulation such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will be.
 - False Christs and false prophets will arise and will show great signs and wonders, so as to mislead, if possible, even the elect.

Let's stop here for a moment. Jesus has progressed from "<u>hearing of</u>" as the mere beginning of birth pangs to "they <u>will deliver you"</u> to tribulation to "<u>when you see</u>."

At this point it is important for us to remember that people of different eras are reading Scripture. Depending on when you are alive, you may be reading prophecy or you may be reading prophecy fulfilled. Case in point is Christ's first coming. To people living in Old Testament days, Messiah's first coming was a prophecy of a future phenomena - a virgin birth ushering God the Son to the world in human form. Unbelievable!

We look back at the prophesied virgin birth and see it as fulfilled, history.

- 5. Was "when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION spoken of through Daniel" (Matthew 24:15) historical or future to the disciples?
- 6. Jesus used Daniel's prophecy of the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION to answer the disciples question when will these things happen and what will be the sign of Your coming. Some Christians believe Jesus was pointing to 70 AD when the Romans attacked and destroyed Jerusalem. Some believe Matthew 24:15 was fulfilled when Antiochus Epiphanes, a Greek king, raided the temple in Jerusalem, set up an altar to Zeus, and sacrificed swine on the altar leading to the Jewish Maccabean revolt. While both of those events did take place, it's important to remember the question Jesus is
