

# JOHN 2



## Cana of Galilee & Jerusalem

Jesus performs His first sign that He is God by turning water into wine at a wedding at Cana of Galilee, drives the money changers out of the temple at Passover at Jerusalem, and declares, “destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up,” prophesying His death and resurrection.

### Key Verses

*“His mother said to the servants, ‘Whatever He (Jesus) says to you, do it.’” John 2:5*

*“Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.” John 2:19*

### Doctrine: Resurrection

John 2:19 Jesus was crucified, buried, and raised the third day (1 Corinthians 15:3-4) fulfilling prophecy and proving He is the Son of God (Rom 1:4). Jesus' resurrection makes certain the resurrection of believers to eternal life (Rom 6:5).

### Divisions/Key People

1-12 Jesus turns water into wine at a wedding at Cana causing His disciples to believe.

13-25 Jesus drives the money changers out of the temple and prophesies His death and resurrection.

**Passover:** Commemorates when the Lord delivered Israel from Egyptian bondage. March/April

**Feast of Unleavened Bread:** Part of the Passover celebration during which the Jews ate unleavened bread and celebrated the beginning of the wheat harvest.
