

JOHN 10



Jerusalem, Feast of Dedication, & Perea Province Beyond the Jordan

Jesus teaches that He is the Door, He is the Good Shepherd who lays down His life for the sheep, and He gives eternal life. The Jews want to stone Him, but Jesus eludes them and goes beyond the Jordan where many come to Him and believe.

Key Verse

"I came that they might have life and have it abundantly," John 10:10.

Doctrine: Substitution

Jesus "lays down His life" (John 10:11, 15, 17, 18) as a substitute for sinful man. John 11:49
"...it is expedient...that one man die for the people..."

Divisions/Key People

- 1-10 Jesus says He is the Door through whom people can have abundant life.
- 11-18 Jesus says He is the Good Shepherd whose voice is known by His sheep.
- 19-38 Jesus tells the Jews that He and the Father are one; that His works testify the Father is in Him and He is in the Father.
- 39-42 Jesus eludes those seeking to stone Him and goes to the Perea province.
