Jesus tells Martha He is the Resurrection and Life, weeps at Lazarus tomb, raises Lazarus from the dead, then leaves because of the conspiracy to kill Him.

Key Verses

"I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies, and everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die. Do you believe this?" John 11:25-26.

Doctrine: Resurrection

Jesus said in John 5:28-29, "Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice, and will come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment."

Divisions/Key People

- 1-16 Jesus delays going to heal Lazarus.
- 17-27 Jesus tells Martha that He is the Resurrection and Life.
- 28-38 Jesus weeps at Lazarus' tomb.
- 39-44 Jesus lifts His eyes to heaven, prays, and calls Lazarus from the tomb.
- 45-57 Jesus raising Lazarus causes many to believe, but the chief priest and Caiaphas conspire to kill Jesus.

Last week of Jesus's earthly life before He was offered as the ultimate passover lamb, slain before the foundation of the world. Also known as Passion Week.

"Then came the Day of Unleavened Bread when the Passover must be killed. And He sent Peter and John, saying, "Go and prepare the Passover for us, that we may eat." (Luke 22:7-8)
